

The purpose of this site is to (1) protect birds from deadly window collisions and (2) promoting safe years so that native plants can benefit wildlife. The site has had over 4,000 visits.

All the information on the site has been reviewed by experts, such as Dr. Daniel Klem and Dr. Martin Rossler. The material has been prepared by a retired attorney who has led bird window collision prevention and native plant promotion efforts in his community for four years. He set up his sunroom as a display room where neighbors can come by and choose the system they want. He has also installed both the commercial and DIY versions of all the scientifically sound systems. Broad information on the scope and science of bird window collisions can be found at the American Bird Conservancy or the Acopian Center for Ornithology.
